

Garbage Not Collected at Designated Pickup Points

Type	What	Important Information
Oversized Garbage	<p>▼ Oversized Garbage</p>  <p>▼ Small electronics and appliances</p> 	<p>The oversized garbage category includes garbage that is larger than other types of garbage as well as small electronics and appliances. Oversized garbage may be disposed of by taking it directly to a city disposal facility (carry-in charge applies) or using at-home collection (paid service). Small electronics and appliances are items smaller than an 18-liter can that are made of a combination of metal, plastic, rubber, glass, wood, or other materials and cannot be easily disassembled. Small electronics and appliances should be placed in a transparent or semi-transparent bag (should be able to tie closed) no larger than 45 liters.</p> <p>*Wooden furniture that can be broken down to meet burnable garbage size limits can be disposed of as burnable garbage. *Logs, etc. may have a diameter of 10 cm or greater but less than 20 cm. Items with a length of 1 m or greater but less than 1.5 m are classified as oversized garbage.</p>
	<h3>At-Home Collection (Paid Service)</h3>	
	<p>① Call first! (Have a pen and paper ready.) Tell staff your address, head of household's name, telephone number, type of garbage, and number of pieces.</p> <p>② Information Provided by the Collection Center Center staff will tell you where to put your item out for collection and specify a reception number, collection date, and the appropriate fee for your item. Please write this information down.</p> <p>③ Before the Collection Date Purchase an Oversized Garbage Disposal Ticket anywhere tickets are sold. Write your reception number and name on the Oversized Garbage Disposal Ticket and affix it to your item at a location where it can be seen easily. Each item requires a separate ticket.</p> <p>④ Morning of the Collection Date Place your oversized garbage at the specified location for collection by 8:30 a.m. of the specified collection date. You do not need to be present for the collection. (Collection times cannot be specified.) Collection may occur later than 4:30 p.m. in some cases.</p>	<div style="background-color: red; color: white; padding: 10px; text-align: center;"> <h2>Oversized Garbage Collection Center</h2> <h1>(086)435-5300</h1> <p>[Hours] Mon. to Fri. (incl. holidays) 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. (closed weekends and during the year-end and New Year holidays)</p> </div> <p>*Collection locations may include the entrance to a property, near your home's entrance, in front of a garage facing the street, etc. (For apartment buildings, it will be near the first floor entrance.) Oversized garbage should not be placed at designated garbage pickup points. *Items not fully paid for, not found in the specified collection location, etc. will not be collected. •Collection can also be scheduled online via the Kurashiki City website. Specified Home Appliances	<p>Please return items to the place of purchase.</p> 	<p>Air conditioning units (including outdoor units), TVs, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, and clothes dryers are specified home appliances and are not collected by the city as a general rule. If you wish to dispose of one of these items, please return it to the place of purchase.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recycling fees and collection/transport fees are the responsibility of the person disposing of the item. <p>*If the place of purchase refuses to accept the item, one of the city's environmental centers will assist you. The process for such a case is as follows.</p> <p>① Purchase a home appliance recycling ticket at a post office. (Tell the post office staff the manufacturer, size, and model number.)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">↓</p> <p>② Take the item directly to one of the city's environmental centers or use at-home collection. (Both options require an oversized garbage disposal fee.)</p> <p>For further details, please contact the place of purchase or the Domestic Waste Control Division.</p>

Moving Garbage *Large amounts of garbage produced when moving to a new residence should be separated and taken to a disposal facility by the person moving. Oversized garbage resulting from a move can be scheduled for at-home collection (paid service). Please schedule collection at least one week before your moving date.

Business Garbage Garbage generated by retail shops, offices, restaurants, or agriculture and other business activities **should not be placed at designated garbage pickup points**. Please arrange for pickup by a licensed garbage collection contractor.

Uncollectable Items		<p>Concrete blocks, pieces of concrete, roof tiles, bricks, soil, sand, rock, logs (greater than 20 cm in diameter or 1.5 m in length) must be disposed of on one's own.</p> <p>Tires, engine oil, paint, LPG tanks, fire extinguishers, motorcycles (over 50cc), car batteries, dangerous drugs, agricultural chemicals, pianos, etc. cannot be disposed of at city facilities. Please arrange for disposal by the place of purchase or a professional disposal company, etc.</p>
